Regional Business News incorporates 75 business journals, newspapers and newswires covering metropolitan and rural areas within the United States.

Indexes *The New York Times* from 1851 to 2003 with mostly full-text articles.

Specialty Databases

J-STOR

Complete archives of core scholarly journals have been digitized, starting with the very first issues. There is a moving wall of from 2 to 5 years that limits the currency of the journals, this varies by title. The Business Collection includes the full runs of approximately 50 journals.

VAULT Career Library

A collection of career guides covering topics like cover letters, resumes, interviewing, and networking, as well as profiles for over 3000 employers

E-Books

NetLibrary

Includes over 2,500 electronic books related to business. These books may be accessed through the library catalog as well as through the NetLibrary database.

EDGAR

SEC's Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis and Retrieval System -- filings include public companies' registration statements, and periodic financial reports, such as 10-K annual reports, 10-Q quarterly reports, and 8-K current reports, as well as other documents.
